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How does Jolly Phonics work?

Using a synthetic phonics approach, Jolly Phonics teaches children the five skills for reading and writing.

1. Learning the letter sounds	2. Learning letter formation	3. Blending	4. Identifying the sounds in words	5. Learning tricky words
Children are taught the 42 main letter sounds. This includes alphabet sounds and digraphs, such as sh, th, ai and ue.	Using different multi-sensory methods, children learn how to form and write the letters.	Children are taught how to blend the sounds together to read and write new words.	Listening for the sounds in words gives children the best start for improving spelling.	Tricky words have irregular spellings and children learn these separately.

Alongside these skills children are also introduced to the main alternative spelling of vowels. These five skills form the foundation that children build on with each year of grammar teaching.

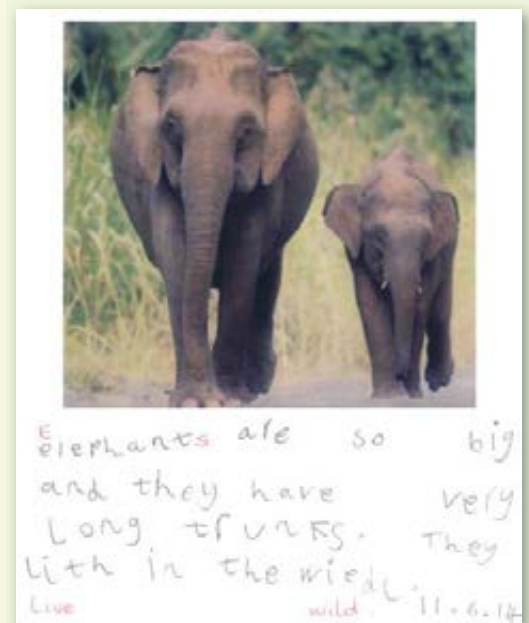

Phonics Section 2: Sound letters

Letter Sound: /ie/

Storyline: A boy is going to a party. Everyone will be wearing costumes. The boy wants to dress up as a sailor, like his dad. His dad gives him a sailor’s hat and shows him how to salute. The boy stands to attention and salutes, saying /ie, ie/.

Action: The children pretend to be a sailor, saluting and saying, /ie, ie/.

Flash cards: Hold up the letters ie, and say /ie/. Point out that although there are two letters, there is only one sound.

Letter formation: It is easier for the children to remember to write both letters if they learn to join them up. Explain how /ie/ is written. The children form the letters in the air in one continuous movement. Then they trace the dotted letters on the Sound Sheet. Finally, they write the letters on their own.

Blending: The children blend the words on the Sound Sheet, pointing to the dot underneath each sound as they say it.

Word bank: Pie, lie, die, trial, squid, fried, crust, dried, unic, verified.

Extension activity: Cut out and decorate paper ties.

FURTHER PHONICS
Useful information for teachers

- When two letters make one sound, it is called a ‘digraph’.
- /ie/ is the long vowel sound of the vowel letter ie.
- When long vowel sounds are written, they usually begin with the vowel letter, followed by another vowel, as in /ie, ee, oo, oo, oo/.
- When two vowels go walking the first does the talking! /ie/ can be written as /ie, ai in /tie/, /y, ai in /fly/, /igh, ai in /high/ and /i, ai, ai in /kiss/. These children can blend six words with confidence; they can be introduced to the other spellings (Phonics Section 13, Alternative Spellings of Vowels, pages 191 and 197-8).
- **ie sound bank:** tie, mine, like, wig, fire, line, price, shine, slide.
- **oo sound bank:** too, try, eye, fly, sky, cry, dry, my, boy, toy, boy, boy.
- **igh sound bank:** high, right, night, light, fight, sight, right.
- The sound /ie/ can also be written as:
 - /i, ai in /kiss/
 - /ai, ai in /kiss/
 - /ay, ai in /kiss/

Grammar 16 – Irregular Verb 'to be'
(Simple present tense)

Aim: Teach the simple present tense of the irregular verb 'to be'.

Introduction: Revise verbs. Remind the children that the infinitive, or name, of a verb begins with the word 'to', as in 'to buy', 'to smile' and 'to write'. Ask for examples of verbs. It may help to show the irregular verbs picture in the *Jolly Grammar Big Book 2*. Encourage the children to give the infinitive form of each verb they suggest, e.g. 'to jump'. Choose one of the verbs and conjugate it in the simple present tense.

Present: I jump, you jump, he/she/it jumps, we jump, you jump, they jump

Write up this conjugation, on the board or on the plastic sheet over the bee hives in the *Big Book 2*. Remind the children that the first three are singular and the second three plural. ('I' is the first person singular; 'you' is the second person singular; 'he', 'she' and 'it' are the third person singular; 'we' is the first person plural; 'you' is the second person plural and 'they' is the third person plural.) Remind the children to add an *s* to the verb root for the third person singular. As a class, conjugate some of the other verbs. Remind the children that these verbs are all being conjugated in the present tense.

Main point: Explain that not all verbs follow this regular pattern. Some verbs are irregular or 'tricky'. The verb 'to be' is very irregular. When parts of 'to be' occur in sentences, children often find them difficult to identify as verbs. It is important to overcome this problem, as the verb 'to be' is used so frequently. Familiarity with it will also help the children later, since 'to be' is used to form other tenses like the present continuous, as in 'I am running'. Conjugate the verb 'to be' in the simple present tense, and write it on the board.

Present: I am, you are, he/she/it is, we are, you are, they are

As a class, practise conjugating the verb 'to be' in the simple present tense.

Grammar sheet 16: As a class, read through the sheet. The children write inside the outlined word, *Verb*, using a red pencil. Then they fill in the parts of 'to be' in the present tense. Next they write in the missing parts of the verb 'to be' to complete the first set of sentences. Then they read the next set of sentences. In each one, the children identify the part of the verb 'to be' and draw a bee shape around it.

Extension activity: The children write out the verb 'to be' on a large piece of paper. Then they draw a bee shape around their writing.

Rounding off: Go over the sheet, with the class identifying the parts of the verb 'to be'.
