



12 Tips For using LEGO® Education in Early Childhood Settings – By Luke Touhill

1. Make LEG0° Education an everyday experience

When children have the opportunity to use LEGO® Education regularly they quickly learn how to use it effectively.

2. Treat LEGO bricks as a creative material

LEGO bricks are a creative material that allows children to explore and express their ideas. Treat it as you would any other creative material – help children learn the skills they need to use it well and then allow them the freedom to use it to express themselves. And don't expect perfection. It's not about creating the perfect model, it's about being creative.

3. Build a collection of specialist pieces

Sometimes children's interest in a particular way or type of building means you need lots of specialist pieces. Consider some of the specialist equipment packs such as vehicle parts, roof tiles or windows and doors to supplement your general LEGO Education collection.

4. Make the LEGO Education area inviting

How have you set up your LEGO Education area? A low table often works well to keep children's constructions off the ground while still allowing children to sit on the floor as they build. Consider whether there is enough space for the number of children who will play there? Are there enough pieces? Does the range of different pieces allow children to build easily and without frustration?

5. Is it easy to find the right piece?

Think about how children will search for the pieces they want — severa containers are often better than one (especially if there are more than 3 or 4 children using the area) and wide shallow containers work better thar smaller deeper ones. If you're really organised consider sorting the LEGC bricks into basic categories to make finding the right pieces even easier.

6. Get involved

As with any play experience, adult support and encouragement makes a difference. Don't assume children will automatically know how to use LEGC bricks. As children are learning how to build you might demonstrate how to use certain pieces. As they become more proficient it might be enough simply to talk with them about what they are building — asking open-ended questions to encourage thinking about what they are doing and what they might do next

7. Make sure there are enough LEGO Education people

Children love to populate their LEGO Education creations with people. Having enough for everyone helps to avoid conflict. A balance of male and female helps, as do multiples of particularly popular characters.

8. Encourage ideas LEGO Education is about being cro

LEGO Education is about being creative but not everyone can be creative in a vacuum. Sometimes too much freedom is as limiting as not enough. Provide pictures and other stimulus to encourage children's ideas. Those who want them will use them, those who don't will build for themselves anyway. Pictures of real life objects, photos of children's previous models and simple instructions are all good ways to stimulate an initial idea.

9. Dig deeper

Young children's LEGO Education creations rarely look like the picture on the box or in the catalogue. Don't be fooled by appearances. The ideas behind such creations are what is most important. To find out the learning that is going on talk to the children about what they have built and why. Documenting their stories as well as their creations can be a powerful way to show the learning and ideas that LEGO Education inspires.

10. It's not all about the building

Once children have built something they usually want to play with it. Is there room for this to happen? And what happens to the children's constructions once they've finished with them? Is there somewhere safe they can be kept to show parents and siblings at the end of the day or to return to later in the day? Can educators (or children) take a photo of the mode for future reference or discussion?

11. Look after the LEGO Education area

Keeping the LEGO Education area in a manageable state is important. LEGO bricks that are not looked after can quickly spread everywhere. A chaotic area also does little to attract and engage children's interest or encourage them to keep it tidy themselves.

12. Enjoy yourself

If you've never played with LEGO bricks before then you might find it hard to appreciate how it works and what it involves. Try it for yourself – get a feel for the different pieces and what you can do with them so that you are able to support the children in their play. Above all penjoy watching children's creativity come alive
