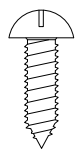
PART IDENTIFICATION-SCALE 1:1-PLACE PART OVER DRAWING TO CHECK CORRECT SIZE



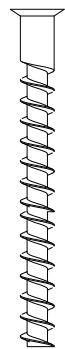
