

# Party, Party, Party!

## Contents:

1 jigsaw playing board, 4 handbags, 28 picture cards, 8 character pieces, 8 character stands, 1 dice

## Object

To be the first player to fill their handbag with one present and five party accessories and join the party in the centre of the board.

## To play

- Each player chooses a handbag and one of the single characters, which they then place in a character stand.
- The board is assembled and the remaining characters are slotted into stands and placed in the centre of the board.
- The picture cards are spread out on the table, face upwards, beside the board and each player places their character on one of the pink arrows in the corners of the board.
- The youngest player begins by throwing the dice and moving their character clockwise around the edge of the board the number of spaces shown on the dice.
- If the player lands on a picture of a present or party accessory, they look for the matching card, pick it up and place it in their handbag. If that card has already been collected by another player, they must wait until their next turn to try to collect an item. Note that players may not hold more than one present card and five accessory cards at any time.
- If the player lands on a square with a dropped handbag, they lose a card and must return one of their cards to the table, face upwards.
- If the player lands on one of the two white squares with a pink arrow and no mobile phone, they may choose to pick up a present or party accessory that has not already been collected and place it in their handbag.
- If the player lands on any square with a mobile phone, they pretend to phone another player. That player must then take one of the cards out of their handbag and return it to the table, face upwards.
- Once a player has collected one present and five accessory cards, they continue to move around the board on their turn until they reach the next path which leads to the party.
- Note that once a player's handbag is full, they may still lose an item if they land on a dropped handbag square or if another player phones them. If a player loses an item when they are on the path to the party, they must go back down the path and around the edge of the board on their next turn to try to collect another item.
- The exact number does not have to be thrown on the dice to reach the party. The first player to reach the party is the winner and may stand their character on the star. The other players can then join the party too!

## The winner

The winner is the first player to collect a present and five party accessory cards in their handbag and reach the party in the centre of the board.
