

Old MacDonald Lotto

Contents:

4 farm boards, 24 farm cards, 4 farmer cards

Setting up

- Each player chooses a farm board.
- The farm cards are spread out, face down, on the table.
- The farmer cards are placed in a separate group, face down, on the table.

Object

To collect all the matching farm cards and farmer shown on the farm lotto boards.

To play

- The youngest player begins by turning over a farm card.
- If the card is shown on the player's farm board, then the player makes the noise or action of the subject on the farm card and then places the card on the matching square on their board. If the item is not on the player's farm board, it must be shown to the other players and then returned to the table, face down.
- Play passes to the person on the player's left.
- Once a player has collected all the items on their farm board, they then need to find their farmer. On their next turn, the player chooses a farmer card. If the farmer matches the one on their farm board, the player places the card on their board and they win the game.
If the farmer does not match the farmer on the player's board, then the card must be shown to the other players and returned to the table, face down.
- Play continues until one player has found each matching farm card and farmer on their farm board.

The winner

The winner is the first player to collect all the matching farm cards and farmer on their farm board.
