puzzle where almost everything begins with
the letter C or D or possibly both.

not. This means that no matter how few or how many
things you find, you are a winner. Also, I can't actually
remember what some of the words I've drawn mean
and some of them are written in a language that
I don't understand.

So just enjoy this puzzle and if you really want to
have a competition you can always challenge
your friends and relatives.
