

Skill Level 4: Colorama for Experts!

(2-6 Players, Ages 5+)

Object of the Game:

Can you be the first to find a space on the game board for all your pieces? Roll both dice to find out!

Getting Started:

- Mix up all the pieces and hand out an even amount to every player.
- Place any leftover pieces on the game board.

Let's Play!

The youngest player goes first.

- Take turns rolling both dice and placing pieces on the game board that match the color AND the shape rolled. (Example: If you roll a green and a square, you have to find a space on the board for a green square!)

Winning the Game:

The first player to get all of their pieces on the game board wins!

Helpful Information:

- This game is very helpful for younger children learning how to identify shapes and colors. Encourage them to call out the colors and shapes of the pieces as they play.
- Add some competition and see who can call out the right colors and shapes first!

Skill Level 1: Discovering Colors and Shapes!

(1-6 Players, Ages 3+)

Object of the Game:

Can you find a matching space for every shape and color?

Getting Started:

- Mix up the pieces and hand out an even amount to every player. The color and shape of the pieces is not important.
- Place any leftover pieces in their matching spaces on the game board.

Let's Play!

The youngest player goes first.

- Everyone takes turns putting their colorful shapes in their matching spaces on the board. (Example: If you have a yellow circle, find an empty, yellow space in the shape of a circle!)

Winning the Game:

The game is over when each piece has found its matching space and the board is full of vibrant shapes and colors! Everybody wins!

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Skill Level 2: Discovering the Dice!

(2-6 Players, Ages 4+)

Object of the Game:

How many pieces can you collect? Roll the die to find out!

Getting Started:

- Set aside the shape die and only use the color die.
- Start by putting all the shapes in their matching spaces on the game board.

Let's Play!

The youngest player goes first.

- Roll the color die and pick any shape of the same color you rolled from the game board. (Example: If you roll the color green, take any green shape.)
- The lucky joker lets you choose whatever color shape you like.
- If you roll a blank, you miss a turn.
- If you roll a color and there are no colors left that match, you miss a turn.

Winning the Game:

When there are no pieces left on the game board, the game is over. Everyone count your shapes! Whoever has the most is the winner.

Game Variations:

Mix it up a little by using the shape die instead of the color die. Only pick pieces from the game board that match the shapes you roll.

Skill Level 3: Colorama

(2-6 Players, Ages 5+)

Object of the Game:

How many pieces can you collect? Roll BOTH dice to find out!

Getting Started:

- Start by putting all the shapes in their matching spaces on the game board.

Let's Play!

The youngest player goes first.

- Play this game the same way as in Skill Level 2, but increase the challenge by using both dice!
- Roll both dice and pick pieces from the game board that match the color AND the shape rolled. (Example: If you roll a green and a square, you take a green square!)
- If you roll the dice and there are no pieces left that match them both, you miss a turn.
- If one of the rolled dice is blank, you miss a turn.

Winning the Game:

When there are no pieces left on the game board, the game is over. Whoever has collected the most is the winner.
